The Temptation of Jesus



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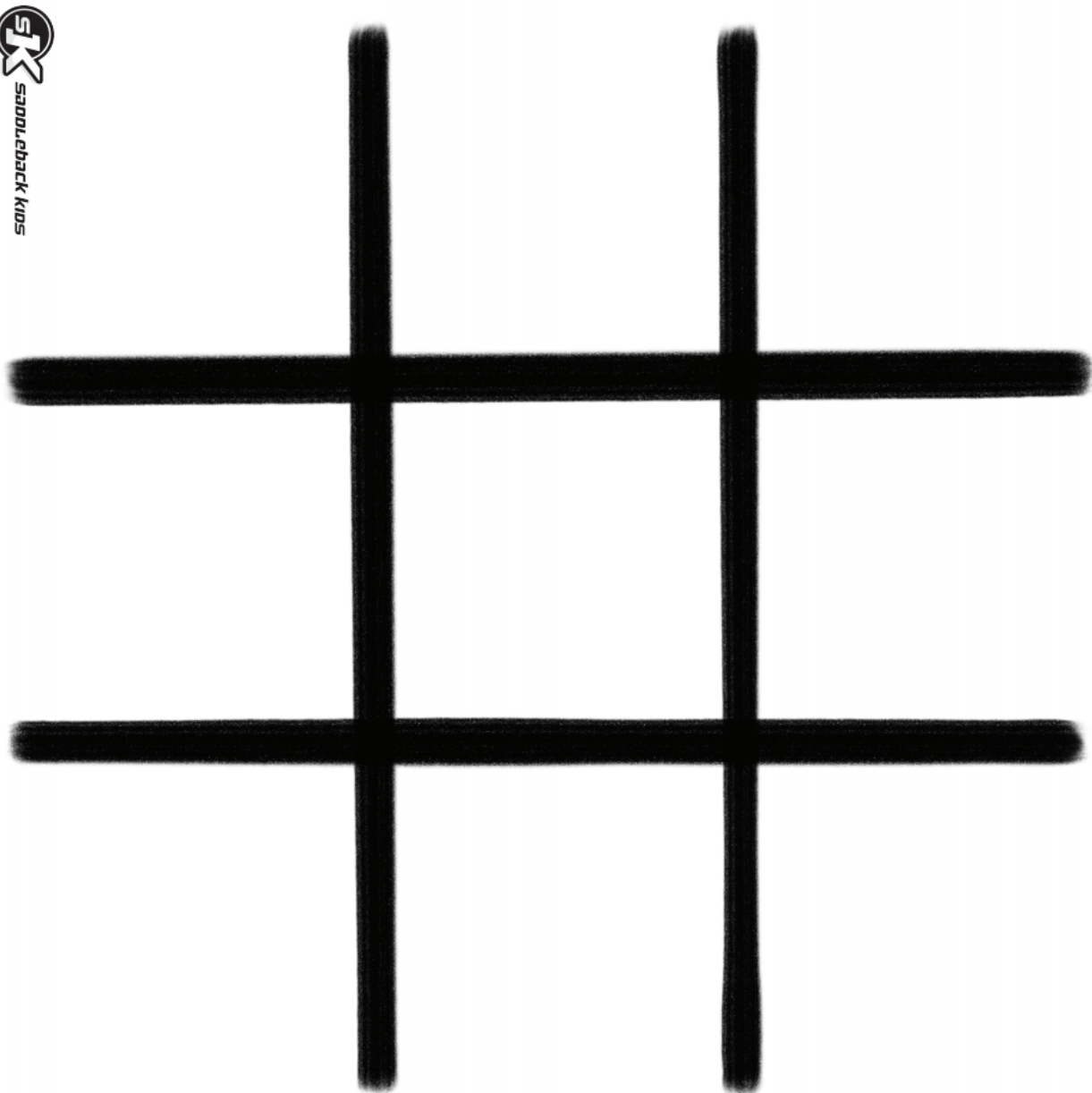

- 3. How can we remember to make wise choices?**

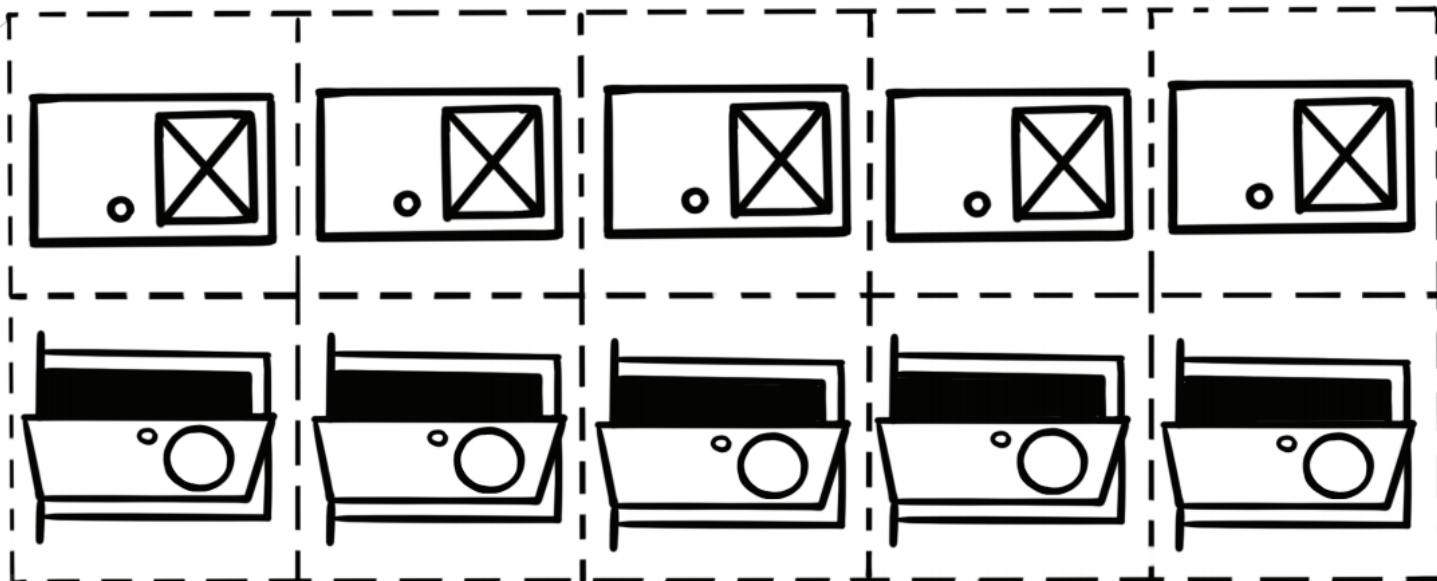
